Peter's remarkable contributions have earned him an honorary doctorate from the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam in October 2012. Additionally, he co-founded Alpe d'HuZes, a charity foundation that has raised almost two hundred million euros for cancer research through its annual mountain cycling event.
