The Diagnostic Development Initiative aims to accelerate diagnostic research, innovation, and development to "speed our collective understanding and detection of COVID-19 and other <u>innovate diagnostic solutions to mitigate future infectious disease outbreaks</u>".

A combination of AWS in-kind credits and technical support will make up the funding for customer research teams use the cloud to tackle the COVID-19 challenge.
