European Society of Intensive Care Medicine Diversity Task Force

In March the European Society of Intensive Care Medicine (ESICM) (<u>esicm.org</u>) announced its Diversity Task Force (pictured), which will draft a policy paper and code of conduct related to gender, gender identity, age, sexual orientation, race, culture, socioeconomic status and multi professionalism. ESICM is the first major international medical society to publicly announce the formation of such a group.
